

# A Different Way To Square Dance TRACTOR DANCING

Tractor square dancing brought humor and fascination to the big arena at the Pennsylvania Farm show at Harrrisburg. Swing your partner round and round...on tractor wheels.

The Roof Garden Tractor Buddies of Somerset County and the Middlecreek Swingers of the Mount Pleasant/Selinsgove areas demonstrated dancing in the style of "down on the farm". But the dancers are not your typical couples with western shirts and gingham skirts. They are big tractors— red Farmalls and green John Deeres.

The group consists of two callers, 14 drivers and devoted spouses. The drivers, callers and an assistant keep the group moving. It takes a lot of practice, coordination, timing and patience. (Sound familiar.) The tractors have different wheel sizes and different gear ratios so what looks like seamless movements to spectators is actually quite an effort of coordination and skill on the part of the dancers/drivers.

This year, they've added some interesting new calls that include *Teacup Chain, Spin The Top*, and a few surpises to make it more interesting. (Hey, if tractors can do it so can you.) The tractors are all older, dating from 1939 to 1953 and all have names, gents and ladies, including Kenny, the only one with power steering. There were no electic starters in '39, so there are some crankers, and Daisy is a yellow Farmall. (Never heard of a yellow a Farmall.)
